Harasement Consultation Center News





In this first edition we introduce the efforts being made to prevent harassment at Nagoya University.

Efforts are being made at Nagoya University to combat harassment based on the "Harassment Prevention Basic Declaration". In 2002 a sexual harassment consultation office was established and consultation was offered in regard to sexual harassment. In April 2009 this was expanded into the Nagoya University Harassment Consultation Center and academic harassment and power harassment are now also being dealt with. Specialist consultation staff offer consultation services to the person who sought the consultation, those around them, and others related to the situation. Counseling care is also offered if needed.

At the Consultation Center we seek a smooth resolution of problems through contact with various institutions inside and outside the University and in this way aim to provide effective consultation services. Your intentions and decisions will be respected at each and every stage of the way. The Harassment Consultation Center has trained and experienced staff ready to help you.
